


Supporting Gospel work in the Gambia

Discipleship...

The charity has parted way with our first evangelist at the end of his probation period. We have all learned a lot through this, please pray for Benjamin and his new wife that they will know God's blessing and direction. We are now actively seeking a replacement who will assist us in making disciples so they in turn can become gospel leaders...organic church.

Evangelism...

We are supporting a church we know well with a mission, by providing funds to bring clean water to 30 family compounds, further assisting in opening the door to the gospel

Outreach...

We are trying to equip our sister charity in The Gambia, The Grace Charity to reach out and share the gospel as they feel led, they are currently formulating a plan for the first 6 months of the year on where they can be most effective. We have provided funds as well as audio bibles, tracts and bibles.

Practical Ministry...

Only 9 families failed to pay their child's school fee for the year (£4.51 max), we are working on how we can support them, considering personal interests, skill-sets and how we can enable them to build a future for their future, ensuring hope.

We are currently supporting 2 enterprises with loan funds and are currently considering 2 more loans to assist start up opportunities, both in agriculture. We have many more requests and are trying to be wise in how we recycle funds to be more effective.
